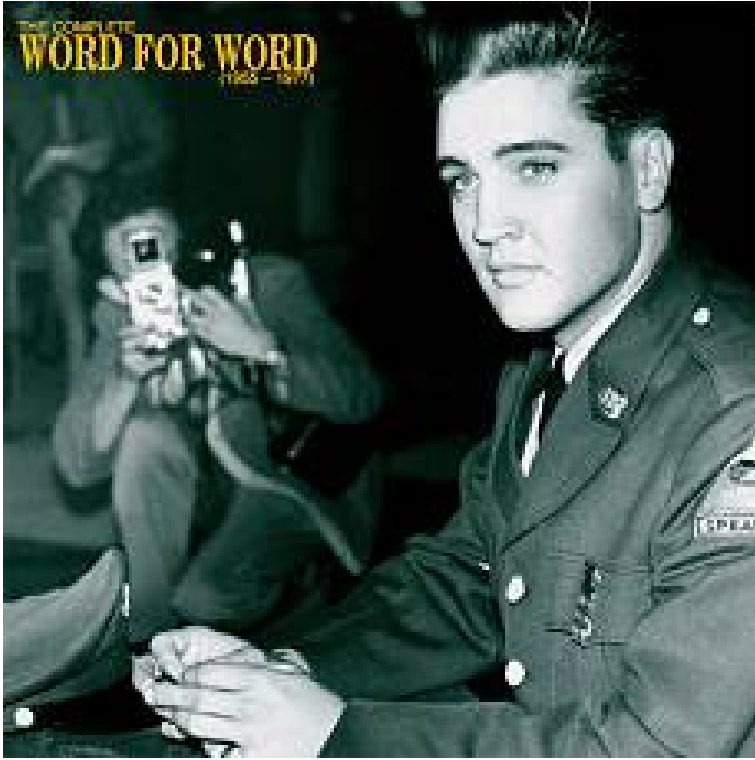


Elvis: Word for Word
