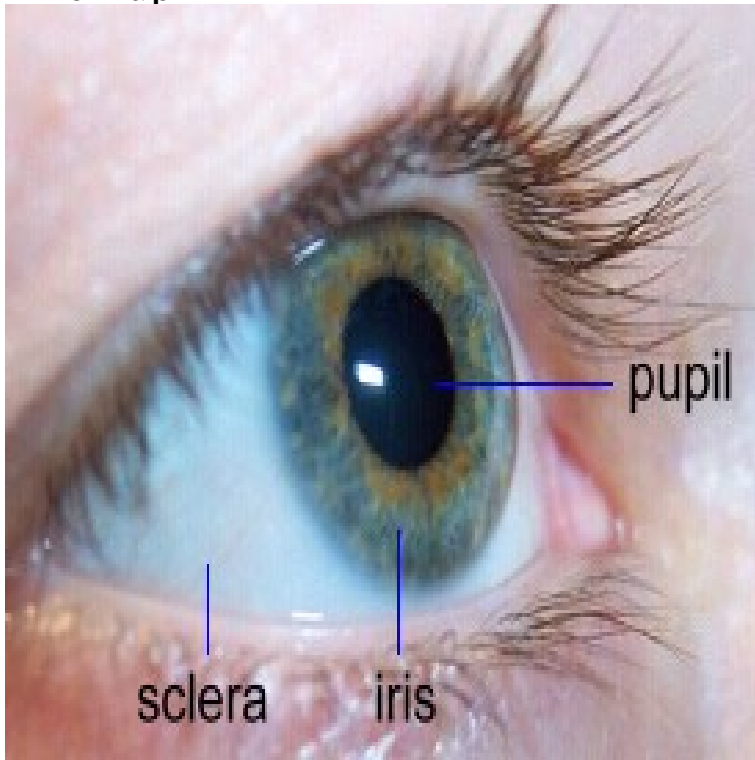


The Pupil



Pupil Definition. The pupil is the opening in the center of the iris (the structure that gives our eyes their color). The function of the pupil is to allow light to enter the eye. **Pupil:** Pupil, in the anatomy of the eye, the opening within the iris through which light passes before reaching the lens and being focused onto the retina. In the eye, the pupil is the opening in the middle of the iris. It appears black because most of the light entering it is absorbed by the tissues inside the eye. **THAT'S THE WHY: ARE YOUR eyes blue? Brown? Maybe green or grey?** When we talk about eye colour, we refer to the coloured ring of tissue. You may not think there is much to the pupil of the eye, but it's a window to your emotions and a key feature in managing the amount of light that enters. **Definition.** The normal pupil size in adults varies from 2 to 4 mm in diameter in bright light to 4 to 8 mm in the dark. The pupils are generally equal in size. You can watch the pupil of your eye change size in response to changes in lighting. The iris is a ring-shaped membrane inside the eye that surrounds an opening in the center, called the pupil. The iris contains muscles that allow the pupil to contract and dilate. The pupil of a person's eye has a diameter of 2 to 4 mm.
