Heather J. Sharkey (U Penn) will present on her current work -- a history of Muslims, Christians, and Jews in the modern Middle East, focusing on the mid- to late nineteenth century.

Dr. Heather J. Sharkey is an associate professor in the Department of Near Eastern Languages and Civilizations at the University of Pennsylvania. She is the author of *Living with Colonialism: Nationalism and Culture in the Anglo-Egyptian Sudan* (2003) and *American Evangelicals in Egypt: Missionary Encounters in an Age of Empire* (2006). With Mehmet Ali Dogan, she edited *American Missionaries and the Middle East: Foundational Encounters* (2011). She has contributed to many edited volumes, including *The Oxford Handbook of Modern African History* (2013), *Just Wars, Holy Wars and Jihads* (2012), and *Introducing World Christianity* (2012). She has published in periodicals such as the *International Journal of Middle East Studies*, the *Journal of African History, Islam and Christian-Muslim Relations*, the *Journal of Imperial and Commonwealth History*, and *African Affairs*. She is on advisory boards for *The International Journal of African Historical Studies*, *Church History and Religious Culture*, *Islamic Africa*, *Northeast African Studies*, and *Social Sciences and Missions*.
